What was funded?

Pathways to Employment

A collaborative effort by the City of Davis, Davis Community Meals and Housing, and Davis business and faith organizations to develop employment skills and provide opportunities to persons who are homeless. Employing up to five individuals who are homeless at a time, Pathways to Employment matches participants with job training opportunities.

Getting to Zero Vouchers

A temporary rental assistance and case management program for individuals who receive homeless priority points in the application for subsidized housing provided by Yolo County Housing.



How much did we do?

21 Individuals Served

- Number of individuals served by Pathways to Employment | 14
- Number of individuals served by Getting to Zero Voucher Program | 7
- Average age of individuals served | 48 years
- Number of chronically homeless individuals | 4
- Number of individuals who left the program | 4



How are people* better off?

7 Housing Outcomes

- Obtained a housing subsidy or voucher | 2 (29%)
- Exited to permanent housing | 5 (71%)

7 Case Management Outcomes

- Obtained permanent employment | 7 (100%)
- Received case management services after securing permanent housing | 7 (100%)
