## GETTING TO ZERO | Strategic Investment Summary 2017



### What was funded?

#### 5 Grantees | Homeless Prevention, Rapid Rehousing & Other Services

The City of Roseville completed a study to identify needs of the local homeless population and used that information to provide homeless prevention, rapid rehousing and other homeless services in Roseville to address identified needs. The City invited local non-profit agencies to submit applications to be funded under these service areas, and required local collaboration and use of the local Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) as part of the grant. Five agencies were funded to provide homeless prevention, rapid rehousing, and other homeless services.

#### 2,058 Individuals Served

#### 3,115 Services Provided

Number of completed assessments | 2,058

#### 880 Housing Outcomes

Exited to permanent housing | 781 (89%)

Exited to transitional housing program | 97 (11%)

Exited to residential treatment facility | 2 (0.2%)

#### 724 Case Management Outcomes

Obtained health insurance | 355 (49%)

Obtained CalFresh | 265 (37%)

Received new form of monthly income | 104 (14%)
