What was funded?

Pathways to Employment

A collaborative effort by the City of Davis, Davis Community Meals and Housing, and Davis business and faith organizations to develop employment skills and provide opportunities to persons who are homeless. Employing up to five individuals who are homeless at a time, Pathways to Employment matches participants with job training opportunities.

Getting to Zero Vouchers

A temporary rental assistance and case management program for individuals who receive homeless priority points in the application for subsidized housing provided by Yolo County Housing.



How much did we do?

19 Individuals Served

Clients served by Pathways to Employment | 9

Clients served by Getting to Zero Voucher Program | 10

Average age | 52 years

Clients who left the program | 7



How are people* better off?

12 Housing Outcomes

Obtained a housing subsidy or voucher | 2 (20% of individuals served)

Exited to permanent housing | 2 (20% of individuals served)

Still in permanent housing after program exit | 8 (80% of individuals served)

12 Case Management Outcomes

Received case management services after securing permanent housing | 10

Obtained employment | 2
