## GETTING TO ZERO | Annual Strategic Investment Summary 2018



### What was funded?

#### 5 Grantees Homeless Prevention, Rapid Rehousing & Other Services

The City of Roseville completed a study to identify needs of the local homeless population and used that information to provide homeless prevention, rapid rehousing and other homeless services in Roseville to address identified needs. The City invited local non-profit agencies to submit applications to be funded under these service areas, and required local collaboration and use of the local Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) as part of the grant. Five agencies were funded to provide homeless prevention, rapid rehousing, and other homeless services.

### How are people better off?

#### 1,194 Housing Outcomes

Exited to permanent housing | 410 (7% of individuals served)  
Clients still in permanent housing after program exit | 407 (7% of individuals served)  
Obtained a housing subsidy or voucher | 316 (5% of individuals served)  
Exited to a transitional housing program | 45 (1% of individuals served)  
Exited to a residential treatment facility | 16 (0.3% of individuals served)

#### 15,453 Case Management Outcomes

Obtained basic needs | 14,449  
Received new form of monthly income | 251  
Received case management services after securing permanent housing | 198  
Obtained permanent employment | 161  
Obtained health insurance | 158  
Obtained CalFresh | 137  
Maintained permanent employment | 99



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
